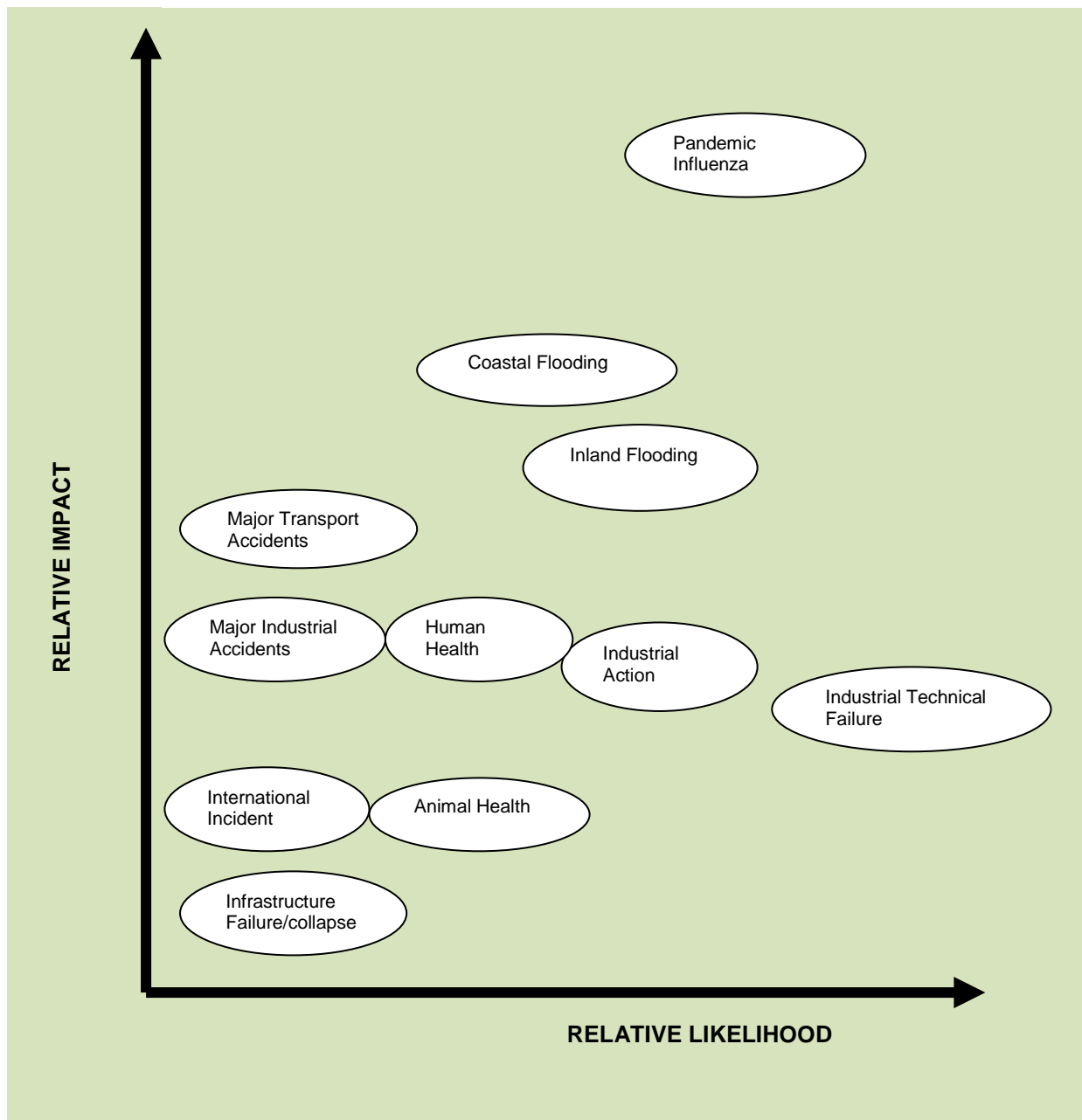




## Bournemouth, Dorset & Poole Local Resilience Forum (*the LRF*) Community Risk Register

The Civil Contingencies Act 2004 ('The Act') places a legal duty on organisations that form part of the Bournemouth, Dorset and Poole Local Resilience Forum (*the LRF*) to produce a Community Risk Register. Why? Because there is a need to assess the risk of an emergency occurring in the LRF area, and from time to time assess the risk of an emergency and to develop plans and responses that mitigate these risks, and to inform the public that this is taking place.

The LRF has looked at a number of risks occurring in the Bournemouth, Dorset and Poole area and has developed plans to mitigate these. Figure one is a pictorial representation of some of the risks in themes. These risk themes form the basis of continued planning and preparing to make the Bournemouth, Dorset and Poole area a safer place.
